Public Speaking Procedure – Introduced 13th December 2011

The following criteria should be followed:

- If there are a number of the public in attendance each address would be limited to 3 minutes per person.
- All questions and answers addressed through the Chair.
- If on the same topic, then two people to represent the whole group.
- May put any relevant question to the Council or Community Councillor.
- There will be no discussion in answering the question or visa versa.
- Where the six month rule applies, the question may be put, an answer shall be given providing it had already been discussed and any new fact relating to that topic an explanation of Rule 36 and whether Special Reasons apply or are requested by a Councillor.
