DT 102/19 Correspondence
a) Cty Cllr J Pugh – Builth Wells & District Adult Support Event

Email from Cllr as follows:

DT 104/19 Co-option

One application had been received from Mr Stuart Bridgewater.

Resolved: to co-opt Mr Bridgewater to the Community Council. A new advertisement will now be produced for the remaining spaces.

DT 105/19 County Councillors Report

Cty Cllr Williams reported the following matters:

- a) He had visited Chapel Road but had been unable to locate the area of flooding. Cllr G Price stated that someone had been on site and created a small ditch. Cty Cllr Williams will ask an officer from PCC to contact Cllr Price to meet him on site.
- b) Salt Bins had been requested, but were still not in site. Cty Cllr Williams suggested that the Council write to PCC. This was agreed.
- c) There will be an election on 12th December 2019 – this was not discussed due to Purdah.
- d) On Caerwnon Lane, one side of the hedge has been cropped down, however, the hedge along Smithfield remains uncut. Cty Cllr Williams will chase this up.
- e) The issue of flooding still continues by Cilgynfydd along New Road. Cty Cllr Williams will visit the site and report this to PCC for action.

DT 106/19 Information

a) Leaves – Howey Village

Cllr Price reported that some clearing work had taken place on the approach and exit to Howey Village, however, the build-up of leaves is significant.
