County Councillors Report

a) Footpath, Cwmbach

Some repair work is to be carried out to the footpath outside no 1 and 2 of Troed y Rhiw, and barriers have been installed. A new planning application has been submitted for the drop kerb.

b) Cty Cllr Williams had recently held a visit to several sights within D&T and PCC have refused to install a pillar at the bottom of Chapel Road, they will carry out repairs to the roadway between Brynhir and Ty Gwyn.

- c) A new Salt Bin has been placed at Caerwnon Park to replace the one which was stolen. Adoption of the slip road by the A470 between Oaklands and Dolfor has now been agreed and PCC will start this process.
- d) Caerwnon Bus Service – the PCC Cabinet has decided to remove all bus services to and from Caerwnon Park. Cty Cllr Williams has suggested a possible compromise by re-routing some journeys of the 44 bus to serve Caerwnon Park. This is being investigated.
- e) Sunnyhaven – there has recently been an accident and a vehicle has ploughed into one of the dwellings on Sunnyhaven. Cty Cllr Williams has written to the Minister with regard to this.
